CABIN INFO

All cabin units have a personal bathroom with at least one sink, toilet, and shower in them. Also, please note that all cabins (*with the exception of Diamond*) are set up with bunk beds. For example, when a cabin is described to have 10 twin beds, it is set up with 5 twin bunk beds. All of the bunks have mattresses, but families must bring their own bedding (*except for when staying in Diamond, the hotel-style cabin*).

Hilltop Cabins

Rustic cabins located on the hilltop area above the Gym and Dining Hall

- Jasper and Crystal
 - 4 units each, 2 of which have 6 twin beds and 2 of which have 4 twin beds
- Agate, Amethyst, Topaz, Amber, and Pearl
 - 1 unit each with 10 twin beds each

Emerald & Sapphire Cabins

Original lakeside cabins in the central part of camp near the Dining Hall

- Emerald and Sapphire
 - 2 units each with 10 twin beds each

Carnelian, Beryl, & Jacinth Cabins

- Carnelian
- Newer lakeside cabin in the central part of camp near the Dining Hall*

- 8 units with 5 twin beds and 1 full bed each

- Beryl

Lakeside cabin in the central part of camp near the Dining Hall

- 8 units, 4 of which have 6 twin beds and 4 of which have 5 twins beds and 1 full bed

- Jacinth

Newer lakeside cabin across from the Welcome Center

- 8 units with 5 twin beds and 1 full bed each

Diamond Cabins

Hotel-style rooms overlooking the lake—linens, towels, and amenities provided

- Diamond
 - 8 units, 4 of which have a queen bed and pullout couch and 4 of which have a full bed and twin bunk

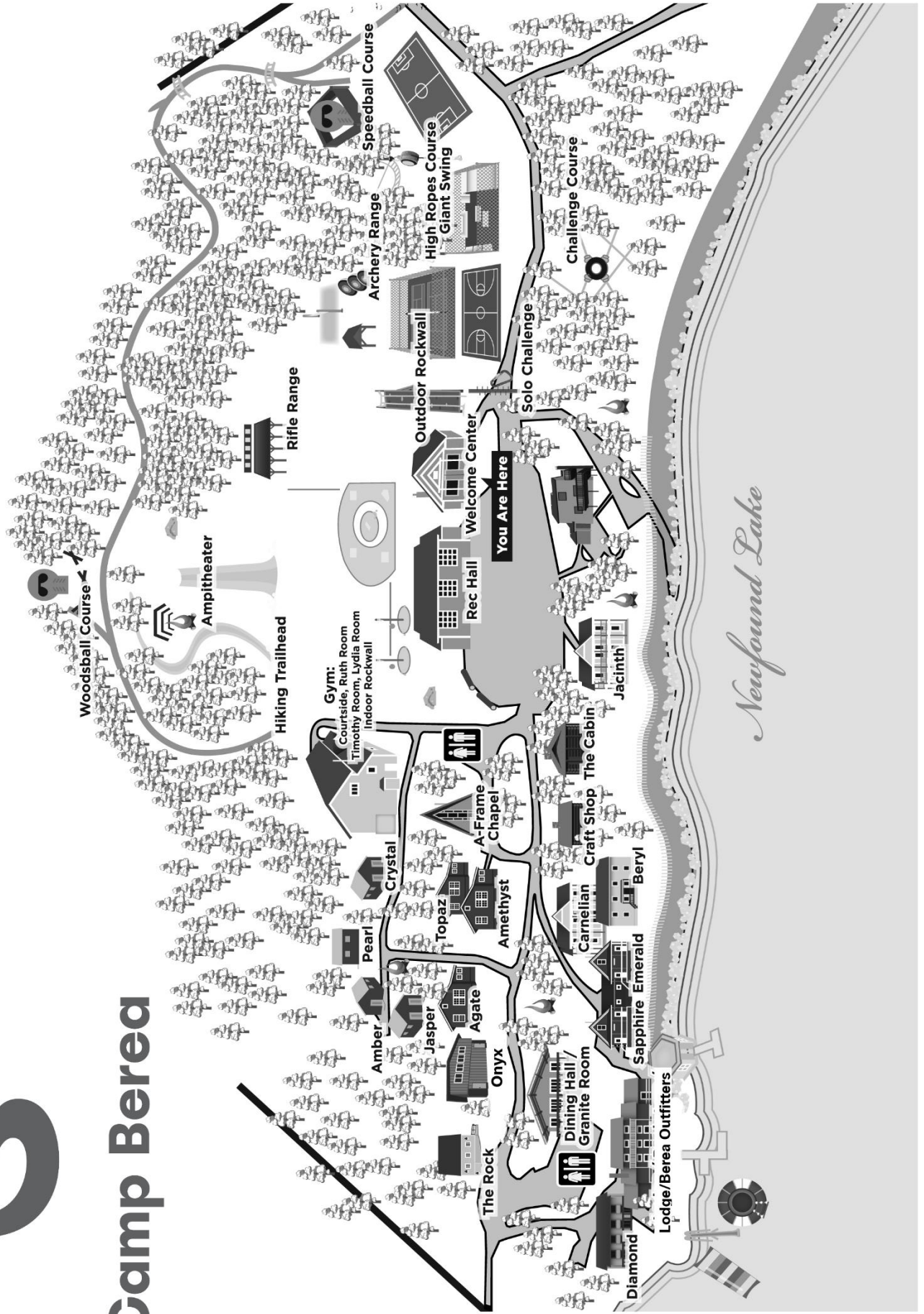

FAMILY CAMP HOUSING POLICY

The purpose of Family Camp is to create a space for families to draw closer to Jesus Christ while growing closer to each other. In our ever-changing culture, it is becoming increasingly difficult for the family unit to stay intact, much less thrive. Our mission is to provide the tools and spaces for families to connect, learn from each other, and grow in the Lord together—all while having fun, memorable experiences!

With this mission in mind, the space we create is protected by certain rules which are determined by the leadership of Berea Ministries. All cabins are to consist of only one family per unit. Berea Ministries defines a family as parent(s), child(ren), foster child(ren) (with legal guardianship), and grandparent(s).

We understand that a cousin or friend of your child may want to experience camp with your family, so we do allow for non-immediate family members and friends of your child to attend with your family and stay in your cabin. These individuals must be under 18 years of age and their parents must sign a permission form (see next page) stating they have given permission for the individuals to stay with your family for the week. *Anyone over the age of 18 is not allowed to stay in the cabin with your family (unless they are the grandparent or parent of those in the cabin).*

Due to the intentionality of our program, we do not advise families to attend for just part of the program. A strong community is built from the beginning of the program to the end, so we do not prorate room rates if you should need to arrive late or vacate early.

Because our mission is to develop strong families and a strong sense of community during our programs, we believe that it is disruptive to have visitors come for the day. However, we acknowledge that some families may desire this option. Visiting hours are from 8 a.m. to 10 p.m. and the cost is \$200 per person, per day. This must be arranged with our office prior to your arrival and this fee is to be paid by the first day of Family Camp.
